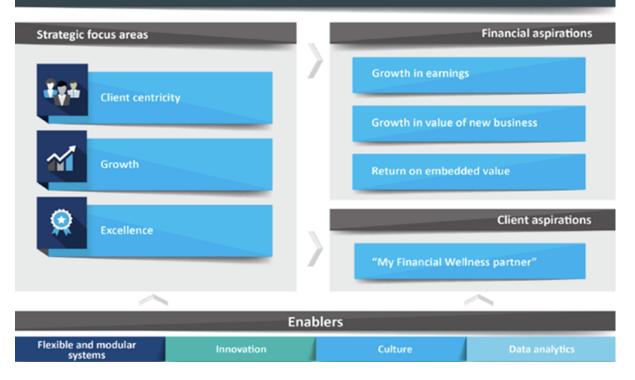

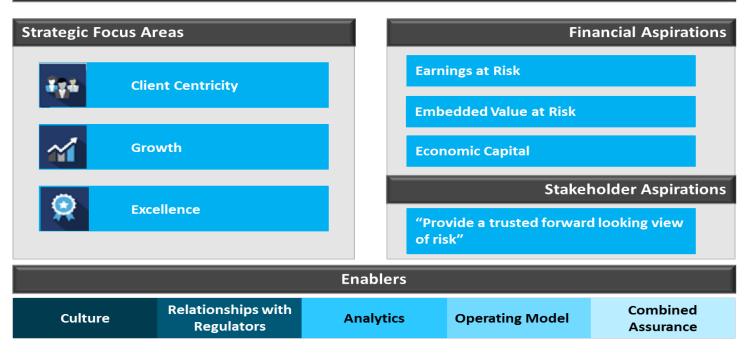

To enable MMI to achieve the appropriate balance between risk and reward, while challenging business to manage risks better, thereby enhancing MMI's reputation with all stakeholders



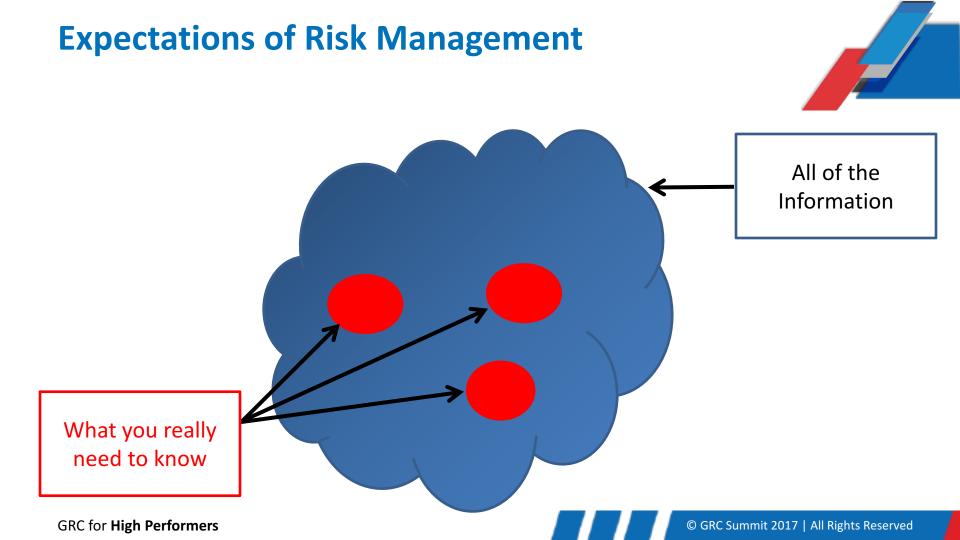






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Expectations of Risk Management









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The need for GRC – Risk Management Perspective

- Complexity and **information** overload
- **Coordinated** and relevant assurance activities focussed on key exposures
- Reduce inefficiency in assurance activities (silos, duplication)
- Synchronisation of reporting **one version of the truth** and transparency of information
- Harmonisation of taxonomies and "way of work"
- **Cost effective** and **efficient** delivery of assurance
- Enable different lines of defence to deliver on their individual accountability through collaboration

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- Satisfy **regulators expectations** of control functions (risk, compliance and audit)
- Balance "how we spend our time"

GRC Program Strategies



Program Strategies

- Appoint an accountable person for driving the implementation of the program
- Established strong accountability and governance with Risk Executives and Risk Teams
- Establish committees to address aspects related to changes in the way of work and changing expectations of existing roles
- Dedicate existing resources in MMI to implement the technology component (MetricStream)
- Transparent, regular communication
- Consultants used for guidance and insight

Drive the implementation of Combined Assurance

- Risk, Compliance and Internal Audit capabilities working together for the purpose of assuring that MMI meets its objectives
- Combined Assurance allows MMI to set priorities for assurance activities and harmonise across Management, Internal Assurance Providers and External Providers

- Project Oversight
- Monitor Progress and Budget

Solution Design Authority

- Decision on optimal system design based on requirements
- Manage operational implementation of solution

Combined Assurance Design Authority

- Coordination and agreement of combined assurance requirements
- Coordination and agreement of common libraries and taxonomies
- Drive way of work and process changes

Internal Audit Workgroup

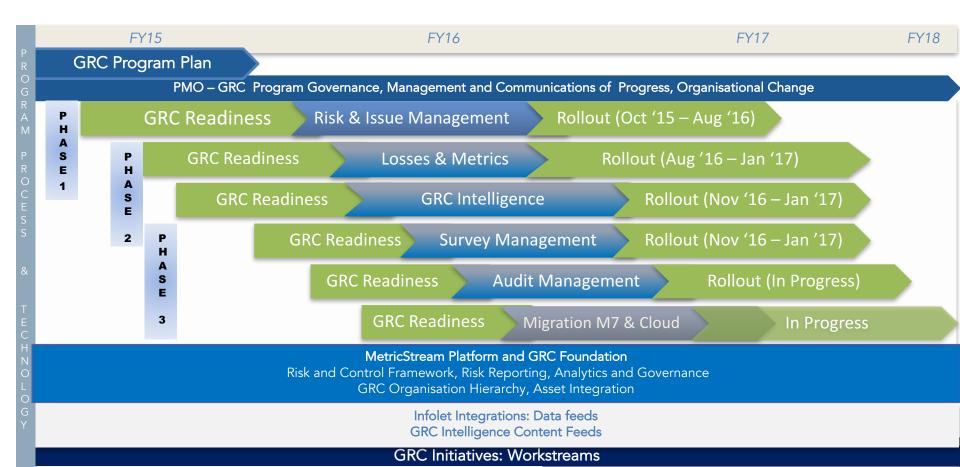
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Challenges

- Many small teams across MMI
- Different ways of work and no enforcement of methodologies and risk processes
- No technology solution in place for 5 years (Excel and Powerpoint)
- Changes in Leadership
- Evolving operating model for MMI, requiring new and different skills and thinking from risk management community
- Availability of resources

MMI GRC Program Roadmap and Rollout

Roadmap:

- We started with the end in mind
- Needed to build the end-vision and interdependencies between the different applications we required
- Requirements gathering, build and user testing
- Deployment to end users staggered approach, staged differently to technology build and testing (GRC readiness)

Implementation Rollout Strategy:

- Life after UAT: Maintain enthusiasm and end-user adoption
- Organisation change management
- Communication
- Continuous improvement

- Shift from traditional project methodologies to Agile

- Delivery of meaningful minimal viable products to demonstrate system functionality and enable teams to take the implementation forward

Key Learnings and Best Practices

People

- Visible executive sponsorship
- Realistic expectations (change management)
- Shared ownership
- Begin with the end in mind
- Drive the business value and address changes on roles and expectations

Process

- Utilize a single Taxonomy and Framework
- Understand business case, define outcomes upfront but be willing to change as your journey progresses
- Realign business processes and design for the future
- This is a journey take the time to get it right

Technology

- User-friendly product
- Long term solution
- Elimination of other systems (incl. Excel)
- Use the out-of-the-box / standard functionality as far as possible (avoid over-customisation)

The road ahead for MMI's MetricStream implementation

- Introduce more collaboration between technology and business teams
- Dynamic production support team to assist with technology adoption and maturing the risk management function's usage of the current sets of technology
